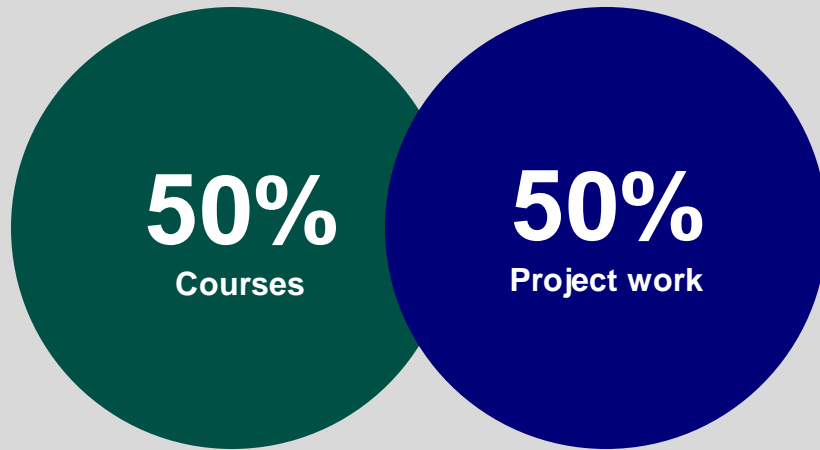

Social sciences analyse, explain and investigate different aspects of our societies, economies and political systems.

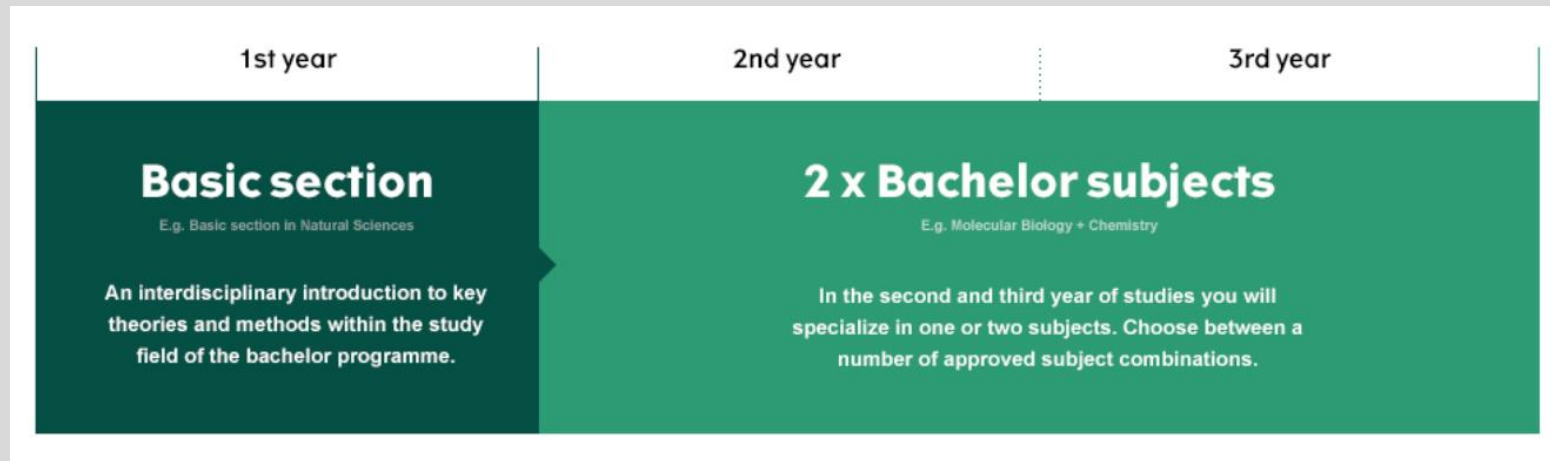
For example
